Bragging Rights:

You saw the African Black Rhino and meet some truly inspirational farmers in three days!

Day 1: Sunday 8th February 2015

After your breakfast, your guide from Fidex Car Hire will meet you at your hotel at 7:00am to begin Day 1 of your 3 day Coffee Field Visit and Safari through magical Kenya. You immediately set off to Sweet waters Sanctuary (www.olpejetaconservancy.org) in Kenya's Laikipia County adjacent to Nanyuki town. The Ol Pejeta is East Africa's Largest Black Rhino Sanctuary, the only place in Kenya to see chimpanzees and hold some of the density in Kenya.



The Aberdare Country Club

You will then return back to your hotel for dinner and to sleep over night at the Aberdare Country Club. The beautiful **Aberdare Country Club**, only a two and a half hour drive northeast from Nairobi, is nestled on a slope of Mweiga Hill in the Aberdare Highlands, part of the Great Rift Valley. Considered a heritage property in Kenya, *The Aberdare Country Club* has retained the charm of a private home with the simple comforts of a country inn. Day 2: Monday 9th February 2015

After breakfast, your guide from Fidex Car Hire will meet you at your hotel at 7.00am and set off on Day 2 of your 3 day expedition through Kenya. You will visit the **Gikanda Farmers Cooperative Society**. Gikanda FCS is FLO certified for 3 years running and enjoys modern Office complex and drying and processing facilities in her 3 factories. It commands good prices in the auction due to her sound crop husbandry program and Good Processing Practices.

You will then visit **Central Kenya Coffee Mills** for a cup of the finest Kenya Coffee! Following this your trip will take you visit meet an **inspirational female coffee farmer, Jane Njambi**, who has 450 coffee trees in her expansive farm, each producing about 13 kilogrammes against a national average production of 2.5 kilogrammes per tree she is a great example of how women are moving up the ladder in coffee farming.

Following your lunch at the Greenhills Hotel, you will proceed to the **Sasini Coffee Estate (Mweiga Estate) which is 1100 acres to listen to the story of Large scale coffee farming.**

Guest will then sleep over night and have a beautiful dinner at The Sportsman's Arms Hotel (or similar) also in Nanyuki (www.sportsmansarmshotels.com).

Day 3: Tuesday 10th February 2015

After breakfast you will go for a coffee field visit to the Nthimbiri Farmers' Cooperative Society located in Meru County. Nthimbiri Farmers' Cooperative Society (NFCS) is committed to ensuring that the operations at all their members' farms who grow coffee and our factories which process coffee adhere to the highest standards of quality control and management in production methods, handling, storage and transportation to the final cup quality

Guests will have lunch in Meru.

After lunch coffee tour driver will take you back to Nairobi for dinner and overnight.
